The Key Connectivity Gateway Between The U.S. and Mexico

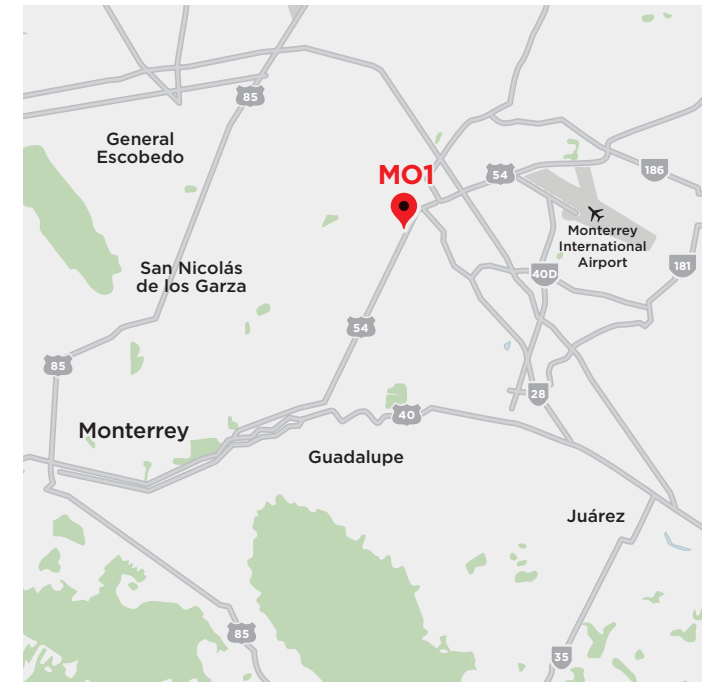
